- Applications received for regular processing of SIRBs and scheduled for release from a
 Rebrusty 2014 to 31 March 2012 are now ready for release at COUNTER1, Releasing Area of the Manpower Development Service (MDS), MARINA Central Office
 located at 5th Floor, Parkview Plaza, 984 Taft Avenue corner TM. Kalaw Avenue, Ermita, Manila.
- Applications received for regular processing of SIRBs and scheduled for release from a
 <u>April 2014 to 30 June 2014</u> may be claimed starting 16 July 2014 at <u>COUNTER 2</u>.
 <u>MARINA Central Office</u>.
- These SIRBs may be claimed personally by the applicant OR in case the applicant is already deployed or onboard a ship, by a duly authorized representative, upon the presentation of the following:

a) Original Copy of the Official Receipt (OR);

b) Anthorization Letter from the applicant-seafarer; AND,

c) Valid ID of the representative.

4. Expedite processing and release of SIRBs on the same day shall be applicable only to applicant scafarers scheduled to depart from the country within three (3) days of application, and upon presentation of their confirmed plane tickets and/or daly approved POEA. contracts. The same shall apply for those scafarers with appointments for Visa issuance within the three (3) days of application. Release of expedite processing shall be claimed at COUNTER 3, MARINA Central Office.
